

DMT - Dive Medical Technician (US)

Course overview:

This course provides a comprehensive overview of the critical roles, responsibilities, and legal obligations of a Dive Medical Technician (DMT) within the subsea industry, with an emphasis on ensuring safety and compliance. Practical skills are developed through instruction on performing routine checks and calibration of recompression chamber equipment in adherence to certification standards.

By the end of the course, participants will be able to:

- Assess divers' physical fitness
- Conduct post-dive evaluations to monitor recovery and detect symptoms
- Conduct neurological assessments
- Administer first aid and advanced medical care for diving-related injuries or conditions
- Identify symptoms of diving-related emergencies and implement appropriate treatment protocols
- Administer drugs and intravenous and inter muscular injections
- Perform inspections and maintenance of hyperbaric chambers to ensure safety and compliance
- Calibrate and test medical equipment associated with hyperbaric treatment
- Administer hyperbaric oxygen therapy to divers for decompression sickness or related conditions
- Conduct emergency drills with dive teams to ensure preparedness for medical incidents
- Accurately record all medical assessments, treatments, and incidents
- Review and update medical protocols to align with standards and best practices within
